Smith the following articles to wit: One hundred and set She Wares, one set plates & Bakes one two Gallon Jug, One Chest One Table One Clock One set for Dogs One pair fire Dogs, & Chairs 1 Cow and Rider - and I further give and bequeath to my beloved Sister - Fanny Smith One bed and two Pillows 5 Counter Panes & Blankets & Sheet Linen & Coverlets and all my wearing clothes and I also give and bequeath unto my beloved nephew and niece Wm. and Eliza Smith Lewis & Orinda called Gamaliel 1 Clock and side Bed and one large Bed and I also give and bequeath unto my friend L. J. Peter Smith 1 grey mare and One load of hay and I also give and bequeath to my nephew Michael Polyan Fann 1 small black 1 Two year old Horse 1 small Pot and 2 Kites and 100 lbs. tobacco out of the vat of the plantation and one or two Tobacco - And I also give and bequeath unto my beloved nephews Winifred & George the following part of the legacies of the property to be equally divided among the above named parties - And I further direct my executor to make sale of my largest Coal and pay my debt with the money I do hereby make and declare and I appoint my esteemed neighbor and friend Wm. Walker executor of this my last will and testament in witness whereof Winifred Smith the said testator have to this my will written on one sheet of Paper set my hand and seal this eighteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty one Signed Sealed and Published in the presence of

Fourthly I give to my daughter Billy Smith one negro Girl named Mary. Fifthly I give to my daughter Elizabeth Porter one negro Girl named Phoebe. Sixthly I give to my son John Singleton one negro boy named Jefferson. Seventhly I give to my son Thomas Singleton one negro boy named Willie. Eighthly I give to my daughter Almida Singleton one negro Girl named Ann. Ninthly I give to my son Hugh Singleton one negro boy named Thomas and the plantation I now live on at the mouth of his mother. Tenthly and lastly after all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid I give and bequeath to my wife Eliza Smith all the balance of my Estate both real and personal to have and to hold at pleasure also I do constitute make and ordain My wife Eliza Smith my sole executrix of this my last will and testament and I do hereby utterly revoke and disavow every other former Testament Will, Legacies and bequests and Ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament.
