I Viniford Smith of the County of Blount and State of Tennessee Minister do make and publish this my last will and testament hereby setting and making record all former wills by me at any time heretofore made and first by this that my body be morally buried in a manner suitable to my condition in life and as to such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to intrust me with to dispose of the same as follows First I direct that all my debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my decease as possible out of my money that I may die free and clear of or that may first come into the hands of my Executor from any portion of my personal Estate Secondly I give and bequeath unto my beloved brother Wm Crittenden the following articles to wit One leather Bound Book Name the Name One set plates & Books One two gallon Jug One Cloth Case Table One Clock One set for Dogs One pair fine Dogs, 6 Chairs 1 Cow and Rider - and 12 bushels grain and bequeath to my beloved Sister Young Smiths One bed and the Pillow 5 barrels flour & establish a short Stage & cover land and all my remaining lands and I also give and bequeath unto my beloved Stephen and Maria May and Elisabeth Gourie 1000 acres of Land 1 Clock and Picture and the said one large Table and I also give and bequeath out our beloved children Peter Crittenden 1 grey mare and 1 black colt and I also give and bequeath to my wife and friend Sarah Walker Farm and small house 1200 year old House 10 small Pot and 2 Kettle and 10 Pounds Corn out of the rest of the plantation and one or two Pots - And I do so give and bequeath unto my beloved wife the Henry Ford Brewer the following part the balance of the property to be equally divided among the above named parties - And I further do at my request make sale of my largest Coal and pay my debt with the money I do hereby make and declare and affront my esteemed neighbor and friend Mr Walker Executor of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I do sign and seal this eighteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty one
