



At the age of God knows May the twentieth 1823  
 George Sedford of the State of Tennessee and County  
 of Blount being late in body but in perfect mind  
 and memory and willing to mind the just acts of my  
 body knowing that it is appointed for all men once to  
 die do make and ordain this my last will and testament  
 and as touching such earthly estate wherewith it has  
 pleased God to bless me in this life I give devise and  
 dispose of the same in the manner and form following  
 In the first place after all my lafaldets is paid I  
 give my beloved wife Polly the use of my plantation  
 and all my farming tools with all the household furni-  
 ture to be at her disposal during her life or otherwise  
 with my old servt man for the use of the farm  
 And where she fails it is my will that any executors pro-  
 vides for a suitable beast for that purpose but in case  
 of my wife passing again it is my will that she should  
 have the one fourth of the plantation the cows two bulls  
 and a heifer given her for the use and service of my executors  
 the cows and heifer to be at her disposal the plantation to  
 serve to the use of my son Jacob I also allow out of the money  
 now amongst our hands that my executors purchase for a  
 brother the second place of them that my two young  
 sons are entitled to with all other cattle not wanted  
 to be kept in the farm and the proceeds to be paid to the less  
 advantage for the use of my other heirs with all the other  
 money which may be allotted also my plantation and all  
 other property that may be in the possession at the date  
 of my death to be sold and equally divided among  
 my three daughters viz) Peggy Hamil, Polly Sedford and  
 Jane Sedford to be appropriated to them use and to their  
 heirs forever It is my will also that James Long & sons  
 have ten dollars in the last place I constitute make  
 and ordain James Sedford Esq and William Hamil  
 my only and sole executors of this my last will and  
 testament, revoking all former wills & testaments and  
 in witness hereof I do hereunto set my hand and  
 seal this day and year above written George Sedford  
 Signed sealed and published by me  
 and declared as my last will and testament  
 in presence of us the subscribers  
 Robt. Sedford

I Keny Sed of Blount County and State of Tennessee  
 as hereby make my last will and testament the manner and  
 form following that is 1<sup>st</sup> of note that all my just debts  
 and funeral expenses be paid by my executors hereafter  
 named 2<sup>d</sup> after my debts and funeral expenses of give  
 to my daughter Polly Del one head and its furniture which is  
 called but head and one other wood and furniture equal to  
 the second head and furniture that my daughter Sally Whit  
 exchange of and one Cow black in the sides and white  
 on the back and Calf also small and white with four  
 toes and his Saddle 3<sup>d</sup> I give to my son John Del one  
 black mare and bridle for myself stayned by him  
 and one plow and all its utensils 4<sup>d</sup> I give to my son  
 Isaac Del one horse Saddle and bridle equal in value  
 to the one my son John Del to be paid to him by my exec-  
 utors when he arrives at the age of eighteen years  
 5<sup>e</sup> I desire that all my personal estate not otherwise dis-  
 posed of to be sold at publick sale and as for my land  
 I wish it sold by my executors which you may see in  
 their wisdom think best either in publick or private sale  
 6<sup>f</sup> I give to my two sons John Del and Isaac Del out of  
 the proceeds of said sale each one his hundred and fifty  
 dollars and to my four daughters Crissy Morris, Caly  
 Morris, Polly Del and Sally Whittemburg each one twenty  
 dollars 7<sup>g</sup> I give to my son Jacob Del one dollar  
 8<sup>h</sup> I give to my son Samuel Del one dollar  
 9<sup>i</sup> I give to my son Peter Del one dollar  
 10<sup>j</sup> I give to my daughter Eli's abt Murphy an order  
 11<sup>k</sup> I desire the balance of my estate to be equally  
 divided equally between Crissy Morris, Jacob Del, Caly  
 Morris, Sammily Del, Polly Del, Peter Del, John Del and  
 Sally Whittemburg and Isaac Del and if it should amount  
 to more than one hundred and fifty dollars to each  
 and every one by a reduction of thirty dollars out of  
 each of my four daughters or any Crissy Morris, Caly  
 Morris, Polly Del and Sally Whittemburg their Eli's abt  
 Murphy is to have and equal share of the balance  
 with the other four named children 12<sup>l</sup> I desire that  
 my two sons John Del & shall have the profits arising from  
 my land until sold - and lastly I do hereby constitute  
 and appoint my son Samuel Del and my two friends  
 David Low and Henry Whittemburg Executors of my last  
 will and testament hereby revoking all other wills by  
 me hitherto made in witness whereof I have hereunto  
 set my hand and seal this 28<sup>th</sup> of October in the year  
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twelve  
 Signed sealed published and declared by  
 Keny Sed   
 designated to be the last will and  
 testament of the above named Keny Sed in presence  
 of us who at his request and in his presence have  
 hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses to the  
 same William Ellisper for C. Ellisper  
 Nathaniel Rock Jr.
