I call to witness these presents Samuel Winter
Know ye that I Samuel Winter of the County of Potowmuck
and State of Pennssee being weak in body but of perfect
mind and memory do make this day last will and
testament. 1st my will is that all my just debts be paid by
my Executor hereafter to be named out of the proceeds arising
from my personal estate. 2^d I will and bequeath unto
my wife Charity the use of the plantation I live on
including &c much of my personal property as will be
sufficient for her support during her natural life or until
my death. 3^d I will and bequeath unto my sons David
John Joseph and Andrew five dollars to each of them also
to the sum of my daughter Hannah five dollars
4th will and bequeath unto my daughter Polly one
Pound year supposed to be worth fifty dollars
5th will and bequeath unto my daughters Nancy
Sally Ann and Minnie each one hundred and fifty
dollars and each a tract of land with forty dollars and
each a binder also each a cow worth ten dollars
also each a head and furniture worth twenty dollars
also other household furniture worth twenty five dollars
to each of them, 6th I will and bequeath unto
my son Samuel Ninety five Acres of land off the
last end of the tract of land I now live on
7th I will and bequeath unto my son Sterling a tract
of land adjoining the tract of land I now live on containing
one hundred and nine acres, 8th I will and bequeath
unto my other two sons Joseph and Stephen the balance of
the tract I live on to be equally divided between them by
them giving my wife Charity her support as before mentioned
9th I will and bequeath unto my son Samuel
Sterling Joseph and Stephen the balance of my estate
to be equally divided among them except one bay mare
which I will and bequeath to my wife Charity
Lastly I constitute and appoint my friend Robert Meth-
ew and my son Samuel Executor of this my last will
and testament见证ing all oaths hereupon by me made
in a testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my seal this second day of March

ture as my desire It is my will that after the death of my
wife Charity Whitaker that my daughters Elizabeth and Connor
shall have the farm and plantation I now live on and
also what property of stock and household furniture &c shall
remain here at this mothers decease as allow to them & it is
my will that Jacob Miller & shall have complete entry of
Lloyd joining Mr Johnson Peter Farmer and others in witness
whereof I have done set my hand and seal this fifth
day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and thirty five, 1835. ⁱⁿ ^{the} ^{hand} of Jesse Whitaker

to settle I make this my last will and testament in
the first place I resign my soul in the hands of my
Great Creator God hoping for mercy and a welcome
with him through the Proool Sled for my service by
his dear son Jesus and I resign my body to be buried
in a decent manner at the discretion of my surviving friends
and with regard to what Estate God hath
given me I bequeath as follows in the power of my execu-
tors to sell part thereof if my land to enter the remainder
or otherwise to sell the whole land to purchase another place
with the price thereof in the first place I will give my
dear and beloved wife Agnes the land or the benefit
arising therefrom during her natural life in entirety
for the benefit of raising my children and then I
will and bequeath unto my dear and beloved wife Agnes
the third of my land and all other moveable property
forever I also give and bequeath unto my two sons John
and Jeremiah the remainder part of my land to be equall
y divided and I also give and bequeath unto my two
daughters Hobel and Polly the remainder part of my
moveable property and I appoint this to be my last
will and testament and I appoint John Worham
and Robert Hughes to be the Executrix of this my
last will and testament as made this fifth of
July one thousand Eight Hundred and three in
honor of her unto set my hand and seal.
