CODICILL

I, Samuel Montgomery of Blount County and State of Tennessee, being sick and weak of body, but of sound mind, and disposing memory do make and publish this codicil to my last will and testament heretofore made, but not now at hand; and in addition to the specific legacies set forth in that will, I do hereby make the following attestations and amendments to wit. give and bequeath the three following named negroes two-wit my two black girls Betsy aged about nineteen and Rachael about ten years, and my boy Andy about seventeen years Each of my two sons above named to have an equal and undivided interest in the above named three negroes. I do further requease and be-queath to my son James Montgomery an interest equa l to one fourth the value in the above named girl Rachael and I do hereby require my to sons William Gillespy and John Montgomery to pay him the said James an squevalent equal to the one fourth of the fair estimated value of said black girl Rachael.
