I, Geo. W. Henry, of Blount County, Tennessee, being of sound mind and disposing memory do make and publish this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me at any time made."

First: It is my will that all my just debts, including funeral expenses and the cost of a suitable monument for myself, be paid by my Executor as soon after my death as may be convenient.

Second: I give and devise my home farm where I now live, in the 12th. District of Blount County, to my grand children James Henry and Fred Henry, children of my son Tobe Henry, I also give and bequeath to the said James Henry and Fred Henry all the stock belonging to me on said farm.

Third: I give and devise my farm in the 6th. District of Blount County, known as the Norcissia Henry farm, to my grand children, William Henry, Horace Henry, George Henry and J. D. Henry, children of my son J. D. Henry, I also give and bequeath to the said William Henry, Horace Henry, George Henry and J. D. Henry, four head of work horses to be selected by them from the horses which I have on the farm herein devised to them.

Fourth: It is my will that all the remainder of my personal property be converted into money, by my Executor, and my debts be first paid, and that the remainder of the proceeds be divided equally among all my grand-children. I also authorize my Executor to sell my houses and lots, in what is known as the Maryville Real Estate Company's First Addition to Maryville at private or public sale and I empower him to make a deed to the purchaser or purchasers for the same and the proceeds of same will be divided equally among all my grandchildren.

Fifth: I give and bequeath to my grand daughter, Bois Henry, my "Jenny".

Sixth: It is my will that my children may divide my household effects in any way to suit themselves.

Seventh: I appoint F. H. Lamon, Executor of this my last will and testament.
