WILL OF H. L. FAVERTY.

Elkmont Tenn. Jan. 17th 1921

To whom it may concern

Being in poor health but of sound and disposing mind I make this my last will

First I will the simplest possible funeral and burial; That I be buried as near the place where I die as as conveniently practical and that there be nothing new put on my dead body or the cost of my putting away cost over (\$50.00) fifty dollars

Second: That my doctor and other bills be paid

Third. That my legal heirs are willed and bequeathed One dollar (\$1.00) each

Fourth, That the residue of my estate whether real or personal go to my companion Lydia Faverly

I will that the said Lydia Faverly be her own administrator without bond and that she carry out the provisions of this will without let or hindrance

The cash in the Bank of Sevierville in my name is no part of my estate; as it is the property of Lydia Faverly earned by her own labor and carried in my name for business reasons only. So said Bank of Sevierville is hereby instructed to turn over on demand to said Lydia Faverly any balance due my account -
