First. I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid by my Executor out of the first money that may come into her hands.

Second. I give and devise to my niece, Mrs. Ada Swan, my house and lot in Maryville Tenn. where I now reside, and Five Thousand Dollars in money.

Third. I give and bequeath to my nieces, Arena Hooke and Elida Hooke, One thousand dollars each; and to my nieces Mrs. Eva Kerr and Mrs. Udora Griffith and my nephew, Marsilius Hooke, of the state of Texas, one thousand dollars each.

Fourth. I, also, give and bequeath to my nieces Eva McCampbell and Mrs. Ella Oldham, of Knox County, Tenn. one thousand dollars each; and to my grand-nieces Mrs. Edith Knox and Idell McCampbell, of Knox County, Eight hundred dollars each, and the part given to Miss Idell McCampbell to be held and kept by Mrs. Edith Knox until Idell shall become twenty years old.

Fifth. I give and bequeath to my niece, Mrs. Ella Means, one thousand dollars in addition to what she and her husband owe me.

Sixth. The rest, residue and remainder of my estate to be equally divided among my my nieces.

Seventh. I nominate and appoint my niece, Miss Elida Hooke to be Executrix of this my last will and testament and I release her from giving bond as such Executrix, having full confidence in her honesty and integrity.
