Huffstetler to have one bed Sted and fall leaf table and my Carpenter tools and I want Mollie Collins to have one bed Sted the old one and Leticia Best the oak Bed Sted and I want Ann Hale to have the Dresser and Ross Lane my book press and Robert Best my trunk and I want Charles Armstrong my Grand Son to have my phonograph and I want all my farming tools and buggy and any other property not mentioned herein with my house and lot Sold on Six and Twelve months time with interest from date and a lien Retained on the house and lot until the purchas money is fully paid and after the proceeds of Sale is all paid in I want my Doctor bills all paid and my Funeral Expenses all paid and the rest of the proceeds to be divided Equally between all of my children less \$70.00 dollars paid in advance to my Sone William Huffstetler and I hereby appoint Henry Blevens Executor of this my last will and Testament in witness where of I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this 16th day of July 1910

R. F. MISER

Know all men by these presents that I R. F. Miser Sr being of sound mind and good memory; and being in feeble health and Knowing the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death, do make and publish this my last will and testament, revoking all wills by me at any time heretofore made.

1. If I will that all my Just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of the first money coming into the hands of my executor

2. " I will and bequeath to my Great nephew Campbell Azro Hutton, and his sister

Lizzie May Hutton the one third interest I hold in the Sam P. Hutton farm, containing one hundred and forty two acres and two tracts adjoining- One containing 23 Acres and the other the same having been purchased from I. W. Bowerman, the other tracts being for 74 acres bought from Jesse R. James. All of said land adjoining and being situated and lying in the 5th Dist. Blount County Tennessee. In addition to this realty I will and bequeath to the said Campbell Azro Hutton One bay mare named Burl ^{& One head} and to Lizzie May Hutton One Colt one year old called Charley, and one bed.

3. I will and bequeath the one third Interest I hold in the old homestead where we live and the adjoining added thereto, as follows Homestead 127 Acres, the grandfather Miser tract of 160 Acres, the parcel bought from Thompson Jones and the same being 17 acres and the parcel bought from James D. Dunlap of 11 acres all lying and being in the 5th Dist. of Blount County Tennessee, to my brother G. W. Miser, the heirs of Martha Dyer Dec. the heirs of Lucretia Brickell Dec Sarah Dyer, and R. F. Miser share and share alike

4. " I will and bequeath to my neice ^{Lucretia Hutton} one sewing machine and one corner cupboard

5. If after complying with all the bequests heretofore made there should be any property still belonging to me at my death the same to be sold by my executor, and after pay-ing any debts and expenses the residue if any to be equally divided with the heirs as set out in article 3 in this will.

6. " I constitute and appoint Campbell Azro Hutton as the executor of this my last will and testament and relieve him from making bond, and further authorizing him to sell the lands described in article 3rd herein Either publicly or privately as he may deem to the best interest of the said estate and execute a deed or deeds therefor
