"1st" I direct that all my just debts, including funeral expenses and expenses of administration, be paid by my executor.

"2nd" I give, devise and bequeath to my beloved wife, Sarah M. Seaton all my property, both personal and real, of whatever description and wherever found, all for her uses and purposes during her natural life.

"3rd" Of what remains of my property, either personal or real, after the death of my beloved wife Sallie M., and after her just debts and expenses have been paid I give, unto Leta Trotter One Hundred and Fifty Dollars to be paid to her as follows; Fifty Dollars on or after she shall have reached the age of 16 years and Fifty Dollars in each year after thereafter until she shall have received the said sum of One Hundred and fifty Dollars.

"4th" If after all the bequests hereinbefore mentioned there have been carried out as directed and if any there yet remains of my property either personal or real, I hereby give and bequeath the same to my brothers and my sisters and to their heirs, and to the brothers of my wife Sallie M. Seaton and to their heirs, each to share and share alike.

"5th" I hereby nominate and appoint my wife Sallie M. Seaton sole executor of this my last will and testament and request that she be not required to give bond.
