Know all men by these presents that I, Jasper M. Mitchell of the County of Blount and State of Tennessee being sixty six years old, in my accustomed health, and of a sound and disposing mind and Realizing that life is very uncertain, and that death is certain to all the living, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament,

First I give and bequeath to my beloved son Frank P. Mitchell, after my decease, one hundred and fifty acres of land off of the West side of my farm on which I now live, including all the buildings on said farm and bounded as follows,

Beginning at a corner of said farm to A.C. Montgomery in the lane just west of my orchard and below my well, thence according to the calls of my deed, with said Montgomery line Southerly to the lands of Jas. A. Wilson and thence with the calls of my deed and the line of said Wilson's land to the lands of A.M. Rule and thence with Rules line to the lands of Jas. A. Wilson and thence with Wilsons line to a corner to H.M. Hook being the East corner of my farm near the Hook Road to Maryville and thence in a northerly direction with said Hooks line to my next corner with Hook and thence a straight line through my farm to A.C. Montgomerys lands and thence with said Montgomerys line to the beginning so as to make one hundred and fifty acres Provided That the said Frank P. Mitchell shall amply and satisfactorily support and maintain his mother my beloved wife, Fannie Mitchell during her natural life or her widowhood if she shall outlive me and I recommend that my said wife Fannie and my said son Frank P. live together as at my present homestead. But if my said son Frank P. Mitchell shall at any time fail or refuse to so support and maintain his said Mother, Fannie Mitchell then her necessary support and maintenance shall become and remain a lien on the above described one hundred and fifty acres of land or such part thereof as may be necessary to provide such support for her during the remainder of her life, or widowhood.

I also, give to my said son Frank P. Mitchell all the machinery and Agricultural Implements that may be on my farm at the time of my death and if he shall not have two work horses or mules I give him one or two out of my stock so that he shall have a team of two horses.

Second I give to my beloved wife Fannie Mitchell all of my household and kitchen furniture to use and dispose of as she may think best.

Third It is my will that after my decease my Executor hereinafter appointed shall sell as they may think best all of my Real and Personal property not herein provided for, Collect my notes accounts, Etc. paying just debts and funeral

expenses and divide all of my estate not hereinbefore provided for equally between my other six children, Susan J. Long Martha E. Raulston, Sarah M. Hite, Lucinda Kidd, Tilda A. Cowan, and Mollie Mitchell.

Fourth I appoint Frank P. Mitchell and W. H. Henry the executors of this my will.
