1st. After my decease, I desire that my funeral expenses, & all debts, of mine be paid in full, out of my personalty, & the remainder I bequeath to my beloved wife, Sarah Elisabeth Jane Russell.

2nd. I bequeath to my wife Sarah E.J. Russell, all of my lands & real estate, to hold during her natural life-time.

3rd. After my wife's decease, I desire that my lands be divided between, Robert

4th. I bequeath to Robert M Russell, a tract of land beginning at a cor of H.A. Hamil's on what is known as the Maryville & Morganton public road, thence with said road to a certain Sicamore tree designated as a cor. between him & Salina C Russell, thence to a large rock near barn, thence to head, of Spring west of barn, thence to a mulberry, in a N Eastern course, thence in a northerly course to a Pine, thence with a little variation to another Pine, thence through a short lane, to a Poplar thence to another Poplar, by fence, & thence along fence to a sasafra, thence, with a westerly variation to a polpar, thence direct to a Sasafra, on line of H.A. Hamil, thence with H.A. Hamil's line to the beginning.

5th. I bequeath to Salina C Russell, a tract, of land, beginning on a Sicamore cor to Robert M. Russell, on Morganton Road, thence with line of Robert M Russell, to a poplar the last cor of his, before running direct to H A Hamil's line, thence from said Poplar, in a northerly course, to a stake on line of G. W. Russell, & cor to him, thence to a stone cor. to W.L. Henry deceased, thence with line, & corners of said Henry land, to Morganton road, thence along said road, to Sicamore at the beginning.

6th I bequeath to James B. Russell, a tract, of land, Beginning at a stone cor to W.L. Henry Deed. & Salina C Russell, thence with Henry's line to a stake corner to Wm & Harvey Russell, thence with their line to a line of M.A. Lane's, thence with their line to a line of M.A. Lane, to a stake cor to G W Russell, far enough past cross fence, to take one & a half acres of timber past the crossfence, thence to cleared land, & back with timber to the cross-fence, thence, with cross-fence, on west side of it, to line of Salina C. Russell, thence with her line to the beginning.

7th I bequeath to Geo W Russell, a tract of land beginning at a stake cor to James B Russell, on line of S.C. Russell's thence with her line to a line of Robert M. Russell, thence with his line to a line of H.A. Hamil's, thence with Hamil's line to a line of M.A. Lane's thence with Lane's line to cor of Jas B Russell's thence with J.B. Russell's line to the beginning. This also to include room for a road from the beginning cor along line of J.B. & S.C. Russell to a stone cor. of W.L. Henry's deed.

I having given to my four other children J.S. W.A. & J.H. Russell & Sarah J. Willocks a portion of property heretofore, I have, no bequests to make to them.
