WILL OF W. H. MYERS.

I, W. H. MYERS, of Blount County, Tennessee, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do make and publish this my last will and testament, hereby revoking and making void all other wills be me at anytime made.

FIRST: I direct that all my just debts, if any, including my funeral and burial expenses be paid as hereinafter set forth.

SECOND: I will, give and bequeath to my brother, Pleas Myers, the sum of FIVE (\$5.00) DOLLARS.

THIRD: I give, will and devise to my sister, Mary Myers, my five-sixths undivided interest in and to the farm now owned by me and said Mary Myers, known as the Nathan Myers farm, situated in the 15th Civil District of Blount County, Tennessee, containing 92 acres, more or less, and bounded as follows: On the North by Little River, on the East by Mattie Cameron, on the South by Frank Miller, on the West by John S. Burns. The said Mary Myers to pay all debts and encumbrances whatsoever against my interest in said farm, and pay all other just debts against my estate whatsoever, and to pay Julia Myers my sister, the sum of TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS and John Myers, my brother the sum of TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS, and pay to my two nephews John Hubert Burns and Cecil Burns the sum of ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) DOLLARS each. It is my will that my said sister Mary Myers have at least twelve months within which to pay the specific bequests to Julia Myers (now Julia McCampbell), John Myers, John Hubert Burns and Cecil Burns charged against her in this my last will and testament.

FOURTH: I hereby will, give, devise and bequeath the residue of my property, both real, personal and mixed to my sister Mary Myers.

FIFTH: I hereby nominate and appoint my sister Mary Myers my sole Executrix of this my last will and testament, and I excuse her from making bond as required by law.
