To my beloved wife Rebecca Teffetteller I give the following Life time estate in 38 acres of land lying on the Maryville & Louisville Road together with all buildings this being the property where I now reside Also the rental from the Store building located at Armona, also the use of \$1000.00 now shown by two notes of \$500.00 each due in 9 & 10 yrs. Respt. these being notes given me by Geo. Catlett. The remainder of my estate I wish to be divided equally among my children or my children heirs if they be not living. My Son J. E. Teffetteller now owes me \$2000.00 for which I have no note or other written evidence which is to be figured as part of my estate. I also request that my Son A. E. Teffetteller continue to cultivate the 38 acres as he has in past years giving my wife Rebecca Teffetteller the rentals formerly paid me, if he so desires. In event grass seed is to be sowed on this tract my wife Rebecca Teffetteller to purchase same.

I hereby appoint and designate my Son W. H. Teffetteller administrator without bond and especially request that he look after all settlements as quietly as possible and without any unnecessary expense. I also especially ask and request of my daughter Lizzie McCall that she not allow the management of any part of my estate that she may receive during her lifetime to pass from her.
