Second: After the payment of said debts and funeral expenses as above provided for, I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Harriet Thompson all of my household goods, notes, money and choses in action, in a word all the property of every kind, character and description that I may have at the time of my death, to be her's during her life, and at her death it is my will that whatever remains, if anything, that it descend to and become the property of my son, Pleasant Thompson, provided he takes care of and looks after his mother, but in the event he fails to do so, it is my will that whatever remains if anything, at the death of my wife Harriet, that it be equally divided between my son Pleasant Thompson, and my four daughters Rebecca Blankenbeckler, Anna Ross and Eva and Essie Thompson, giving to each a one fifth.

I hereby appoint my wife Harriet Thompson Executrix to this my last Will, and she is excused from giving bond &c.
