

OCTOBER TERM 1918

IN RE CHARLES BARTLEY BADGETT.

Know all men by these presents, that I Charles Bartley Badgett, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make and publish this to be my last Will and Testament, revoking all other Wills or codicils thereto heretofore made.

First: I direct that all my funeral expenses be paid in full, out of the first moneys coming into the hands of my Executrix hereafter named.

Second: I direct that all my just debts be paid by my Executrix.

Third:

I hereby will and bequeath all my personal property, accounts notes, judgments, choses in action, stocks and bonds, and all other personal property unto my beloved wife, Laura Agnes Badgett.

Fourth: I hereby will and bequeath all of my Real Estate whatsoever may be found, unto my beloved wife, Laura Agnes Badgett, and give her full power, control and authority to use as she likes, and also to sell, transfer and make Deed as she may desire.

Fifth: I direct that my beloved wife, Laura Agnes Badgett, shall act as Executrix of my Estate hereby releasing her from giving Bond and making reports to the Courts.

Sixth: It is my desire that my Executrix shall employ a competent attorney to advise and assist in winding up the affairs of my Estate.

This November 24th 1915.

IN RE ELIZA LAVINIA WARREN

I, Eliza Lavinia Warren, a woman of color, and a resident of Maryville, Tennessee, do hereby make and publish this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all other wills or Testaments, which I may have heretofore made.

First.

I will, bequeath and devise to my son Robert Warren and to my grand-son Henry James Coffin, jointly and in equal shares and in fee simple absolute, all my property and estate, Real, personal and mixed, my real property consisting of a house and lot of ground situate in the 9th Civil District of the Blount County Tenn. and in the 3rd Ward of the town of Maryville, Tenn. on Jail Street and adjacent to the Depot and Railroad tract of the Louisville and Nashville Railroad Company, and being the property and lot of ground upon which I live and have resided for a long number of years.

Second

I nominate constitute my said son Robert Warren and my grand son Henry James Coffin Executors of this my last Will and Testament, and release and relieve them from giving the bond and making the report to the County Court as required by law.
