I John Carrell being of sound and perfect mind and memory do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following First I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Five head of Horses three head of Cattle eight head of Sheep all my stock of hogs all my bee stands all my Farming utensils all my House hold Furniture as her Rightful property Subject to her will and disposal and Lastly all the rents profits and benefits of my lands during her Natural life and at her death to be sold to highest bidder and Equally divided among all my Children I Give and bequeath unto my son Isaac Carrell one dollar I Give and bequeath unto my son William Carrell one dollar I Give and bequeath unto my daughter Ellen or Buckner one dollar I Give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Smith one dollar I Give and bequeath unto my son John Carrell one dollar I Give and bequeath unto my son Alexander Carrell one dollar I Give and bequeath unto my daughter Martha Carrell one dollar and Lastly of any thing Else

I Give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Rebecca Carrell Whom I hereby appoint Sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament Hereby revoking all former Wills by me made And testimony Whereof I have hereunto set my seal this 1st year of our land one thousand eight hundred and thirty three November 23rd 1833
