and Testament in Manner and Form following
that is

1st I give and bequeath unto my son in
law Permanns Lovelace and my daughter Ag-
nes his wife five negro Slaves and their of-
spring if any forever, of the names and ages fol-
lowing that is to say Bets a negro woman of twenty
three years of age and Rachel her daughter
seven years old Sarah five years old Betty three
years old and vice one year old in January next all
the children of Bets I do also give and bequeath unto
my said son in law and daughter two beds and
furniture there to belonging together with all and
every article of my Personal Estate to them and their
 heirs for ever It hereby revoking all other as former
wills or Testaments by me heretofore made

and witness whereof I have unto set my hand and
seal this 28th day of October 1818 Sarah ^{happ}
