in East Tennessee Carter County calling to witness
that it is appointed for all men hence to die
I do constitute and ordain this my last will
and Testament and desire that it may be Received
of all People as such first I give and bequeath my
Soul to God who give it and my body to the
grave to be buried at discretion of my friends
and as for worldly goods and possessions I give
in the following manner

First I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Anna Suggar \$5 I give and bequeath to my
son Mark Suggar \$5 I give and bequeath to my son
James Suggar \$5 I give and bequeath to my son
Suggar \$5 I give and bequeath to my son Julius
both and my daughter Lavina Van house and to my
son Thomas Suggar and to my daughter Polly Pugh
and to my daughter Martha and my daughter
Rebecca Martin and Equal Share of my tract
of land lying in Carter County East Tennessee or
Watauga where Mathias Van house and Anderson
Pierce now live I give and bequeath to my daughter
Honey and to my daughter Sabra Morgan
an Equal part in my tract of land where my
son Thomas Suggar now lives containing one hundred
and fifty acres I give and bequeath my wife Annafall
possession of the tract of land I now live on with
all the farms and orchard and Buildings during
her natural life and at her death William Lewis
and Martin my three sons shall have an Equal
Share of it and of the Centry gaining it and as for
all the debts and heads and house hold furniture
that I own at the death of my wife

shall be divided amongst my three sons namely
William Leavelle and Darton and my two daughters
Harvey and Sabra Equally and I do constitute
and ordain my son William Leavelle and
my son Darton Leavelle the sole Executors of this
my last Will and Testament for me Deceased hereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
16th day of April 1839
