This day William Neil one of the Executors of Robert Southam, deceased
appeared before me Thomas P. Johnson Clerk of the County Court of Clairborne County, and made
settlement for said Southam as Guardian to Burton Southam who was a minor orphan
and Robert Southam being the Guardian of said Burton Southam, and the said Robert
Southam and Burton Southam both being dead, said Southam was appointed Administrator
of said Burton Southam and William Neil the Executor of Robert Southam. In following
Settlement is made, to wit:

It is, was that upon a former settlement
made by Robert Southam, the 26th of August 1847, there was in the
hands of the said Robert Southam the sum of
Int. from the 26th Aug 1847 to the 26th August 1848.
Sum on \$88.77 from the 26th Aug 1848 to the 26th of August 1849.
Sum on \$94.16 from the 26th Aug 1849 to the 26th of August 1850.
Sum on \$99.74 from the 26th Aug 1850 to the 26th of July 1851.
