Guardian settlement with William Nail, 1851.

State of Tennessee,
 Claiborne County, July the 26th, 1851.

This day William Nail, one of the Executors of Robert Southern, died,
 appeared before me Simon S. Johnson Clerk of the County Court of said County, and made
 settlement for said Southern as Guardian to Burton Southern who was a minor orphan
 son of Robert Southern being the Guardian of said Burton Southern, and the said Robert
 Southern and Burton Southern both being dead, and Nail Southern was appointed Administrator
 of said Burton Southern and William Nail the Executor of Robert Southern. The following
 settlement is made, to wit:

It appears that upon a former settlement
 made by Robert Southern, the 26th of August 1847, there was in the
 hands of the said Robert Southern the sum of
