State of Tennessee
Clayborne County I Spencer Edwards being weak in body of sound mind and disposing memory do make and publish this as my last will testament hereby revoking and making void all other wills by me made at any time

First I direct that my funeral expences and all my debts be paid as soon after my death as possible out of any money that I may be possessed of or may first come into the hands of my Executors. Secondly I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Ashtamasa Edwards all my lands and tenements including the plantation on which I now live including the Corp in hands with all the stock house hold and kitchen furnaces so much as may remain after all my just debts are paid or during her natural life or widowhood accept what is after mentioned Thirdly it is my will that the children should all live together with Ashtamasa my wife and it is my will that each of the girls to wit Rachel Edwards & Sally Edwards shall have back one cow and one feather bed and furniture when they become of age or marry if they live together with their step mother & that time an half back of the Corp to wit James Edwards and Sampson Edwards have each of them a noise least James to have the clay bank fully that is now on hands and the same more land as soon as possible and a Colt Rased for Sampson if it can be so and will that Japtha Edwards keep the horse that I loaned him till next fall and then return him to the family & pay a reasonable price into the hands of my Executors and all the goods and chattels lands and tenements that is otherwise bequeathed in this my last will and testament I will and bequeath the same to my before mentioned wife during her natural life or her widowhood to God behaviour if she marry I will that all my estate be sold on a twelve months credit and the money Equally divided amongst all of my children and my said wife to have an equal portion with my children or if my said wife remains a widow during her natural life it is my desire at her death that all my estate be sold as appraised and the money divided Equally amongst all my children to wit the children that is gone I want all be brought upon equality with what they have had her tofore it is my desire that the children that is gone should be made equal if that much can be spared from the family before the death of my said wife accept Martin Edwards I think that he has had his full share and Letty Mayes formerly Letty Edwards and Elizabeth Beck formerly Elizabeth Edwards and Japtha Edwards and George Edwards and Hiram Edwards and Joseph Edwards and Rachel Edwards and Sally Edwards and Anna Edwards and Sampson Edwards and Anna Edwards and

John C. Carr's Will

State of Tennessee Claiborne county February 1st 1843
I now being in my perfect mind and memory and calling to mind that its appointed unto me once to die I therefore make this my last will and testament First after all my just debts is paid I bequeath to my wife Dorcas Carr all my land cleared and uncleared and buildings and all the furniture belonging to my dwelling house and kitchen and all my farming tools and all my stock of every kind that I may possess at my death and all my negroes that I now own or may own at my death these all to be my wife during her lifetime or widow hood and if my wife think at any time that she has more stock on hand than she wishes to keep her and the Executor may sell to the best advantage and if such money arises from the sale then the widow stands in next of let it be equally divided among all my ~~all my~~ children my children names is as follows Anna, Elizabeth James, Sally, before Sally, Sally, Lucinda, Louisa, ten in number and at the death of my wife the property remaining and land and negroes the Executor may sell at a twelve month credit and the money to be equally divided among all my children and now for a testimony that this shall be my last will and testament revoking all other wills I appoint my son James Executor and Dorcas Carr executrix this given under my hand and seal the day and date above written

Henry Moyers Will

State of Tennessee Claiborne county I Henry Moyers do make and publish this my last will and testament hereby revoking and making void all other wills by me at any time made

First Its is my will and desire that all of my just debts and funeral expences be paid as soon after my death as possible out of any monies that may be on hand or may first come into the hands of my Executor Secondly I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Moyers during her natural lifetime the following named land to wit the plantation that I now live on including all the lands that I own in Claiborne county a description and boundary will be more fully seen by reference to the little papers

Thirdly I will and bequeath to my wife the following named property to wit one wagon two head of horses one saddle one bridle two choice cows ten head of choice stock hogs two shovel plows two butt long plows one wheat gun one loom and gearing one flax wheel one cotton wheel fine chairs three bedsteads and furniture all the cupboard and dresser ware all fowls and poultry one chest and all the spinning stuff cotton flax &c and all the grain that on hand of every kind six hundred pounds of bacon two pair of geartwoeding hoes one mattock one chopping axe all the salt and salt debts that on hand and all the leather and iron that on hand

Fourthly I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary the following named property to wit one team colt one brindle cow & calf one bedsted and furniture and four head of stock hogs

Fifthly I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth the following property one colts worth 20 or 25 dollars one brindle cow and calf one sow and three shotes one bedsted and furniture

Sixthly I give and bequeath to my friend Joseph Houston provided he stays and works as he has heretofore one horse saddle bridle and blanket worth sixty dollars in trade and five dollars in cash and two suites of clothing

Seventhly I will and bequeath to my Daughter Adina Williams my son Joseph B. Moyers and Mary Moyers the following named tract of land to wit my plantation lying in Grainger County known as the Joseph B. lot the description and boundary will be more fully seen by reference to the little papers to be equally divided between said three children at any time after Mary becomes to be 21 years of age to have and
