We the undersigned freeholders of Clarendon County,
after being duly sworn have proceeded to set apart to Eleanor Trease widow of William C.
Trease deceased, so much of the Corp and provision on hand as will be sufficient in our opinion to
support her and her family ever since from the death of her husband. We set apart to her
for said purpose the following Article to wit.

One Bushel Cask 10 bushels of salt in the hands of V. Morgan, on the Cabbage and other
Vegetables, three acres of land to wit - the Orchard or Draw field, & the two upland fields.
Forty five dollars out of the proceeds of the sale of the property of said estate or any other
Money on hand for the purpose of buying flour, Sugar, Coffe and other necessaries.
