there of equally <sup>4th</sup> my will and desire are that my Little son David be allowed one house best when attained Lawfully <sup>4th</sup> out of my estate equal in value to the house Best my eldest son has had that I gave him 5th my will and desire are that whomever I have some children that are now grown and should they be come married and go to themselves that my said wife if she should think or believe she can have as much in value for each of the children when they shall get married or go to them selves as the case may be she give to each one of them as much as one father had and signatur together with a cow and half 6th my will and desire are that my said wife and children live and continue in the plantation during her life and widowhood that I am seized of and living on at this time and at her death Spanish and order all of my effects be sold in a reasonable credit for cash and be equally divided among my children Lawfully begotten of my body that is all of the possible goods and effects 7th my will and desire are that whomever I have had two sons Isaac and Pryor Davis at the death of my late wife I wish my said sons to take the Land at its value and pay to the Ballance of the children their portion and keep the said Lottum their true selves all of the a home I make as my last will and testament and appoint my said son Lewis Bogachum my executor and my wife Polly Davis my executrix to carry this my last will and Testament in to effect revoking all former wills or wills that have heretofore been made in Testimony whereof I have here unto set my hand and seal this 15th day of November 1846 signed sealed and delivered in the presence of
