1st Seventy nine dollars to be allowed to the widdow and family of the said Johnson Deceased to come out of the Administrations of the Estate with the addition of the income of the grist Mill and also what soap and Lard is now on hand and also one barrel two year old flour rated at Twenty dollars by the commissioners and two small hoppers valued to nine dollars forty one and one third cents making in all one hundred and nine dollars and forty one and one third cents this being allowed in consequence of the necessary articles not being on hand this day the 20th 1850
