the Gardian of James Hodge one of the minor heirs
of Allen Hodge Deceased and made the following
Settlement as Gardian to wit

The Gardian is chargeable upon a former
Settlement the sum of \$529.26 1/2
To interest upon the same from the 1st
of January 1848 to the 1st of January 1849 31.75
To twenty dollars for the one third of
the Rents of the property said property
renting for sixty dollars per year and
there being three heirs 20.00
