John DICKSON (E) succeeded his father in 1788 as Clerk of the Lincoln Co. Court, serving until 1804, when he took his family to Rutherford Co., TN. He was Deputy Court Clerk for Rutherford Co. in 1806. John & Margaret, born 11 May 1777, died 1865 in Avoyelles Parish, LA, a daughter of Lt. Col. JAMES DICKSON of Perry County,
Tennessee

I believe this James DICKSON is somehow descended from either John (1704-1774) or William (1710-1775), sons of Michael & Nancy (CAMPBELL) DICKSON of Ireland. John was in Chester Co., PA by 1738, then after a short stay in Maryland, arrived in Duplin Co., NC c1741/2. William apparently first went to Virginia, was in Anson Co., NC for a short time, then to old Ninety-Six District, SC by 1750. See Volume II, Issue 2, Summer 1988 for more on these families. Some of their descendants went to west central Tennessee in the very early 1800s, to the area where Dickson Co. (named after one of the family) was created in 1803. Hickman Co. was made from Dickson Co. in 1807, and Perry Co. was made from Hickman in 1818. Names of James' children (such as Hugh, Alexander, Joseph, James) are names used throughout this line. In addition, some of James' descendants migrated to Red River Co., Texas, where some descendants of John and William went. However, I have not been able to identify this James DICKSON in any of the family branches I know about. Perhaps someone has more info on this James DICKSON's ancestry. John is listed in Volume VII, Issue 4, Winter 1993, page 29, as a son of Thomas & Priscilla (---?) DICKSON, but may actually be Thomas' brother, a younger son of Thomas & Martha (ADAMS) DICKSON. John, born 1787 in Hancock Co., d. 1856 in Conecuh Co., AL (not Hancock Co., GA as previously printed). His will was probated 26 Dec 1868 in Conecuh Co.
