The earliest record of the family is found at Dedham, Massachusetts; Freeman 1657; Representative to the General Court, 1669; m. (second) 5th September, 1670, Sarah SAIRE, who d. 1697, widow of William SAIRE. In the marriage of his dau. Joanna to Anthony Fisher, Jr., 7th September, 1647, his wife Joane appears upon the record in a single instance, in giving her assent to a deed of an eighth part of Block Island to John WILLIAMS of "Barnaby Streete in Southwarke within ye suburbs of London."
