 Thomas & his heirs, I do give and bequeath what may be
 coming to my sons William & James and daughter
 Elizabeth to them & their heirs without restriction. I
 have heretofore advanced to my son Archibald the
 sum of \$200 to my daughter to my daughter Samuel
 Kinnough the sum of \$500. to my son Thomas \$940 to
 my son William the sum of \$15. to my daughter Lucy
 & son James nothing to my daughter Mary
 the sum of \$500 - " Whereas John Kinnough is
 receiver of this \$ Woods to Christian Edwards for a
 correctable account now should Kinnough have it to
 pay & hereby authorize the Trustee for John Woods to apply
 the same he may have to pay out of Thomas's part of my
 estate to the use and benefit of Samuel & Kinnough & his
 children. Lastly, I nominate constitute and appoint my
 son William & James Woods as Executors of this my last
 will and Testament. Given under my hand and seal this 31st

 But if he can said Joel should die a minor or without a
 child then my will is that my estate be equally divided
 between my Brothers and Sisters - And lastly I hereby appoint
 my beloved Father James Woods the sole Executor of this
 my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have here-
 unto set my hand and affixed my seal this fifteenth day of
 April 1840
