of February 1836

State of Tennessee: At a Court of Pleas and Quarter Session held for
Franklin County on the 22nd day of February 1836 then a paper writing
purporting to be the last will and testament of Lewis Apperson deceased
was produced in open Court and of record by the Oaths of Richard L. Holder
and George Luedkefith the undersigned witnesses thereto and established
as the true and lawful will of said deceased. This said will notwithstanding
being signed by the Testator who died shortly after said will
was written which was done in strict conformity to his
directions as provided by said undersigned witnesses and it is
ordered that said will be recorded and Solomon Apperson and
Richard L. Holder the Executors named in said will come into
Court their proper persons and renounce the Execution of said
will " In testimony whereof I shew R. Wagner Clerk of said
County Court of the hereunto set my hand at office on the day
and year aforesaid

In the name of God Amen: Whereas I Abraham Floyd of said county
and of disposing memory at present but coming to mind the mortality
of a worldly thing that this Tabernacle must return to the Mother
Earth on the thirtieth day of June in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and thirty-one do Ordain and constitute
this my last will Testament " First I will that after my decease
that my body be decently entombed into its Mother earth from
whence it came in full hope of the resurrection and reuniting of
soul and body and as to my temporal concerns I leave them as follows
First I will that all my just debts be paid out of my Estate
Secondly, I leave to my wife Ann Floyd the one half of my plantation
whereof I now live during her natural life or widowhood and

And said one of us should one son & wife one horse of his own
 choosing out of the stock that may be left they one one horse
 that has no hatch one bed and furniture that belong with a
 bedstead and an equal portion of kitchen furniture and if she
 should marry or at her death I think my Executors hereafter
 appointed to put my child Mary Anne Floyd or her Grandson
 in possession of the above Legacy: third in addition to the Legacy
 above named I leave to my child Mary Anne Floyd one negro
 Girl named Fannet and all the above named Legacy with its
 increase if any and a homestead fifth to half my land thereon
 & now land sixthly I leave to Samuel Jackson my Father in
 Law the privilege that I heretofore gave him of the part of my
 land where he now lives with the privilege that I gave him
 when he came there to have that is to have what he could find
 for his support with privilege of timber &c. as long as he may
 live or choose to abide on said premises but if he moves off & sold
 premises then all claims and privileges cease. seventhly I leave to
 my two grand children son & daughter of my son Joseph Floyd & his
 George Alexander Floyd and Mary Letitia Floyd the balance of my land
 whereon I now live to wit the North East part jointly together
 with all the appurtenances thereto belonging. I leave to my
 son Joseph Floyd Ten Dollars choosing & give him an equal
 share of my Estate before the present Legacy left to them
 eighthly I give that in twenty days after my death I wish all
 the balance of my personal property to be sold and the amount
 thereof together with all the balance of my effect or money
 I leave to be equally divided amongst the surviving lawful heirs
 of my son William Floyd dead and the heirs of my daughter Ann
 Willis deceased in proportion to Anderson & Willis and I leave
 to Anderson & Willis all the notes that I hold on him and Ten
 Dollars that he owes me in money lastly I constitute and name
 and appoint Anderson & Willis my Executors to my last Will and
 Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and affixed my seal the day and year above written recording all
 other Wills or Deeds made and published before signed
