 other appropriations made to the rest of the Estate. To son George
 I leave twenty Dollars for his trouble in settling my affairs &
 collecting debts in Coshima the property which has before this
 date come into the hands of son Andrew shall go to defray
 the expenses of purchasing the Land. I will also that The first
 thousand Dollars Received from Coshima on my account shall
 be given to son Andrew & to assist in paying for his Expenses
 in Behalf of my family before any other donations are paid
 I will also that after the aforementioned bequests shall be
 adjusted the balance of monies belonging to me in whatever
 way shall be deposited in the hands of son Andrew & to be
 employed by him in the that he shall think best for the
 accommodation of his mother my beloved wife during her life time
 as respecting all interest in an estate her & I agree that in
 case son Andrew I shall see fit to do so any thing in obtaining
 it he shall be entitled to all the profits there arising. I will
 that the Land shall be under the management but at the
 discretion of son Andrew & so far as to prevent the same from
 any kind of abuse in sharing or in any necessary distinction
 or wast of timber I will that Capt George Dorrison & W. Albrecht-
 Esq. be Executors of this my last will & Testament. I will
 that this will shall stand to the dissolving & abrogating of any
 & all wills heretofore made by me in witness of all & to be
 at my name date as above

compensation for his trouble out of said money and the rest
to be appropriated to the paying of my land where I live
and if any balance remaining be equally divided amongst
my children all as before hereto set my hand and seal
the 19th of February 1821

and State of Tennessee being sick & weakly but enjoying the right use
of mind & knowing I am mortal and must die do make and ordain
this my last will and Testament in manner and form following

from 32nd I send to my beloved wife Elizabeth Hudson all the
rest of my estate both real and personal during her natural
life or widowhood and at either of the above named periods
I desire an equal division to take place if she survives an
equal division between her and all the children if she be dead
an equal division among all my children yet it is to be
understood that my daughter Mary Hudson formerly Mary
Henny Kelley has received one hundred and five dollars East
which is to be considered as part of her proportionate share
but my daughter Mary being dead what she received in her
life time her husband to receive it and the rest of her proportionate
share be equally divided between her two daughters Fanny
Betty & Mary Kelley and if either of them die before
she comes of age to receive her part I wish that the living one
receive the dead ones part as if they both should be dead before
they come of age I desire this portion may still be that their
part be equally divided amongst my own children and last of
all I nominate and appoint my wife Elizabeth Hudson Executor
& my sons William and Abner Hudson Executors to this my last
will and Testament hereby revoking all other wills heretofore by
me made & declaring this and only this to be my last will and
Testament. In witness whereof I have hereto set my hand
