 I Jesse Goodwin of the State and County aforesaid being aware
 of Body best of sound mind and memory do make last will and
 Ordain this my last will and Testament to wit: First it is my
 Will that all my just debts be paid Secondly I give and
 bequeath unto my beloved Wife Elizabeth Goodwin all my property
 both real and personal for the purpose of raising and educating
 my children but if any of my Daughters shall see fit to
 marry then they are to receive such portion of my property as
 my Wife Elizabeth shall think proper to give them not being
 more than proportionable part. Third it is my will and
 desire that my three eldest sons Allen F, James R. & Joseph
 Goodwin to be educated until they are Masters of Arithmetic
 & I my wife Elizabeth Goodwin to whom I have left all
 my property both real & personal for the purposes aforesaid
 should money or at her death then and in that case it is my
 Will that all my property be divided between all my children
 deducting from said division such share the amount I have already
 given her in case my beloved Wife Elizabeth should marry
 it is my Will that she shall have an equal share with
 my children 5th. Last I appoint Solomon Goodwin &
 Benjamin Hugginsworth Executors of this my last will and
 Testament. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and affixed my seal this 1st day of October 1825

Benjamin Johnston of Lincoln County Tennessee State being
 in perfect health of mind but considering the uncertainty of this transitory
 life think proper to make this my last will and Testament
 after paying all my just debts I should proper to dispose of my
 Estate as follows to wit I bequeath to my beloved Wife Phoebe Johnston
 all the balance of my property during her natural life or widow
 hood and should be equally divided amongst my four Boys
 & I am said that to be equally divided amongst my four Boys
 at the decease of my Wife I also wish all the money that can

be made from the Estate after schooling the children and other
unavoidable expenses to be paid to the poor of one of said and divided as
above I wish those of the children that has not had a horse be as-
signed to have them of the same value as of those that have had.
I constitute nominate and appoint my wife Phoebe Johnson my son
Nedley Johnson & William Taylor Executors to this my last will and
testament. I am under my hand and seal this 14th day of September 1818

me and that they take 7 one hundred Dollars of the money arising as
aforesaid & purchase a negro boy with it of such description as they
may think proper and to be conveyed to them where they shall see
it best said to my Daughter Amanda to her and her heirs forever
Secondly I direct that the residue of the money arising from the
sale of my property and collection of debts as aforesaid be equally
be equally divided between the children of my children.
Lastly I appoint George Percious and Joseph H. H. Executors of this
my last will and Testament hereby revoking all former wills
I am under my hand and seal this 18th of Sept 1826
