State of Tennessee County Court September Four 1850
In my opinion John the Testator in his Testament of William
Lawton died in a sound mind upon Court for
probate and thereupon came James Lawton & Edmund E.
Lawton the executors witnesses thereto who being duly sworn
depose & say they were personally acquainted with the Testator
in his life time that he signed and sealed the aforesaid before
witnessing in their presence to be his last will Testament on
the day it bears date that he was of sound mind & disposing
memory at the time he signed the same and that they signed
their names thereto as witnesses in the presence of the witness
of the Testament. Thereupon it was ordered by the Court that it should
here be recorded as the last will etc. Witness Mr E Taylor Sheriff
of said Court at office this day of September 1850 J W E Taylor clerk.

I Catharine Sanderson do make and publish this as my last
will and Testament hereby revoking and superseding all other Testaments
by me at any time made. First I do declare that my funeral expenses
will be paid as soon after my death as possible out of
any money that I may die possessed of or may just come
into the hands of my Executor. Secondly, I declare that my
grave to have a great stone placed over my grave and
have the grave yard where my husband is & where I desire
to be buried & called in "I thirdly, I declare that my Executor to
take possession as soon as I die before he is qualified of all
my property both real and personal and after he is qualified to
sell the same both real and personal as soon as convenient
and to make in his own name as special in respect to my real
estate as I could if living. Fourthly my share in any legacy which
I had immediately before my death to trust at rest and wait until
such can be affected. Fifthly my share in any legacy which
the children of Thomas Hodges died late of 1000 pounds
dallars each Sixthly I give and beg my wife to the children of Henry
Modena died one half of the remainder of my estate after paying the
Legacy to Thomas his children.第七ly I give and bequeath to
Sarah Paris wife of Mr Paris and Sarah a second wife of George
Hodges of John the son of Henry Hodges in equal shares the balance
or the other half of my estate lastly I do hereby nominate & appoint
John Lawton my Executor for myself wherof I do to this my will set
my hand & seal this 10th day of September 1850

State of Indiana 3 County Court October Term 1850 Then the Last Franklin County Testee and Testatrix of Catherine Sandridge did swear produced in open Court for probate and thereupon Dame Shirley Duncan & Thomas Barnes the saids executors thereto who being duly sworn deposed and say they were personally acquainted with the Testatrix in his life time that he signed sealed and witnessed the same in their presence to the last will & testaments that she was of sound mind and disposing memory at the time she signed the same and that they signed the same thereto as witnesses in the presence and at the request of the Testatrix and on the day it bears date. Wherefore it was ordered by the Court that said will be recorded as the last will and testament of E Taylor child of said bank at office this day of October 1850

James & James Hariford of the County of Franklin County State of Indiana do make this my last will & Testament. First I doth say that all my debts due me out of the first collected by all debts my husband against me etc. - Second I give & bequeath to my dear wife Elizabeth Eddy Hariford during her natural life or widowhood my farm. I also give her all the personal property left after paying my debts which stands to & consideration for her use and benefit etc for the use and service of my maintenance of her and my children. Third I doth give my Executor on the death or marriage of my wife to take charge of my property for the use & benefit of my children. Fourth I doth by my Executor to see no property after my death only so much as shall absolutely necessary to pay my debts. Fifth I doth leave the same to my wife on the trusts and conditions mentioned in the second clause of my last will & Testament. Sixth I obviate all difficulty I bestow the title to my farm in my Executor in trust for the use and benefit of my wife & children. And I do appoint Edward Mathews & Francis W. Donkin my Executor of this my last will & Testament to witness whereof I have set my hand and seal the sixteenth day of November in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and fifty James Hariford
