Sarah Tally all my estate both real & personal of my description
and species of property all my part of my late Father John Tally
Leads also all the part of William Tally Deed which he and
William Tally gave and bequeathed unto me by will both real
and personal property of a very description together one negro girl
named Shirley after the death of my older Rebekah Tally and
her in course of time she & Shirley may live while in the
service of my said mother Rebekah Tally with all moneys and
property of every description I now possessed of or may or may
have any claim on or to after giving my Sister Rebekah Tally
one hundred Thul one florin worth what so ever and Cotton & bone
now or here one Dutch oven and Loom with all pertaining to the
sd Loom. my next want is my just debts to be paid
out of the value of my furnishall property and general expenses
and the sale of the before mentioned perishable property and
Morallies to take place as soon as possible after my decease
My next want is in case my son by his Sister Tally should
not live to the age of maturity or more to possess or enjoy
my before mentioned Estate and property that the whole of my said
estate both real and personal should be divided between my other
Rebekah Tally and brother Samuel Tally so as to give Samuel Tally

one third and the other two thirds to my Mother Rebekah Tally
and lastly my rest and residue and I do hereby witness and
appoint my friend John Bowman Executor of this my last will and
testament hereby revoking all former Wills & Testaments by
me heretofore made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this twenty sixth day of October in the year of
our Lord One Thousand and Eight hundred and Sixty six

Daughter Susan Spyles as much as will make together
with your hundred and Twenty five Dollars already advanced
to her the sum of Five hundred and Twenty five Dollars
being the amount of what I have advanced to my Daughter
Tally Gillaspie. I also desire give and bequeath to my
Daughter Sally Rains as much as will make together
with your hundred and Sixty Dollars already advanced to her amount
to Five hundred and Seventy five Dollars equal to what
I have advanced as aforesaid to my Daughter Tally
Gillaspie. I also give devise and bequeath to my daughter
Socia Estee as much as will make together those hundred
Dollars already advanced amount to the sum of Five
hundred and Twenty five Dollars the sum advanced to my
Daughter Tally Gillaspie and I also give devise and bequeath
to my Daughter Socia Estee a negro woman Slave named
Bettie to have and possess the said Slave during her life not
subject to alienation by her husband or in being whelped
to his posterity but to her own proper use behoof and to her
own chaire use and her own right. I also give devise
and bequeath Sam Henderson Tenant to my Daughter Elizabeth
Dixon one negro woman Slave named Estee also one bed
and furniture also a loom with all the tackle there belonging
the said Slave bed and Loom estimated at Four hundred and
Sixty Two Dollars which together with Twenty Dollars
already advanced amounts to Four hundred and Sixty Two Dollars
and I do further give and bequeath unto the said Elizabeth
Dixon Eighty Eight Dollars to make the aforesaid bequeath equal
to what I have advanced to my Daughter Tally Gillaspie
I also give devise and bequeath to my Daughter Julia
