the house and farm and two beds & furniture two cows & cattle  
her choice first head of hogs all the household and kitchen furniture  
One ax and all my farming tools & one cotton wheel & cords and my  
several more household stuff since 2<sup>nd</sup> the balance of my estate to be  
left here to be sold and equally divided between my children and  
at my wife's decease the part so held to her be sold and equally  
divided as above and lastly I do constitute and appoint my friend  
Joseph Smith Executor to this my Last Will and Testament hereby  
revoking all other or former Wills and Testaments by me her-  
etofore made. In testimony whereof I have herein set  
my hand and seal this 16<sup>th</sup> day of February 1832

I desire at the time of doing the same he was in his perfect senses I saw Nathaniel Cumby & Richard Saunders also subscribe their names as witnesses thereto in his presence and by his request Saunders is dead & Tammay the last inhabitant of house he resided in Greenville District North Carolina Jos Haggard Franklin County get.

The further deposition of James Haggard was taken and sworn to, subscribed before the undersigned Justice of the Peace and for the County aforesaid at the time and place stated in the caption both parties being present the said depositions being written by myself
