 in due form for probate and duly proven by the oaths of J.B.
 Murphree, H. Crawford & John Henry & L. L. L. on Farmstead
 as ordered to be recorded which is as follows:

I Delila Green being of sound mind and disposing memory
 do make and publish this my Last Will & Testament. I first
 1st I want all my just debts paid 2nd All my beds Bed
 clothes and dishes and all my household and all these furniture
 to be equally divided between my dear brothers to wit
 William Henderson F.M. and Peter Green except one set of silver
 table and one set of silver tea spoons which I give to
 Peter Green for which he is to account to the other heirs
 3rd I give to the said Peter Green my barrel horse or
 gelding and above his interest herein after relinquished
 by me and I give my saddle to my niece Mary D. Green
 daughter of John J. Green 4th all the balance of my estate
 both real and personal is to be sold by my Executor
 at public or private sale as he may deem best
 the proceeds on one & the realty on one and two years
 and he is hereby directed not to incur the expenses
 of procuring a decree of any Court for said sale
 5th I direct that proceeds of said sale to be equally
 divided between my brothers and Jane T. Green the widow
 Lillian Green and the children of Albert Green and the child
 of Felix Green to one share each that is all my
 Green's children one share and Felix Green's child one
 share 6th the share or interest relinquished to John T.
 Green is for the sole and separate use of him and his
 family known and not liable to the debts or contracts
 of the said John T. Green here before included or
 hereafter to be received the said John T. Green is hereby
 appointed to control said share and interest but is
 not to dispose of the principal. I hereby nominate
 Canastota and appoint my brother William Green
 my sole Executor to this my last will and Testament
 this Jan 4 1870

management or control of his Mother she is not to receive
the same until he arrives at the age of twenty one
years I further affirm Peter Green the guardian to the
said James the son of Felix Green & hereby affirm
nominate constitute & appoint William Green my Brother
Executor to this my last Will & Testament this 24th Sept 1870

Eighteen Hundred and Seventy I James T. Brown of County and
State aforesaid being Committed that I can't live but a short
time and being desirous that all my business should be left
so as to give general satisfaction and give all my children
as near an equal proportion as is possible and being possessed
right minded and reasonable services I do hereby in the
name of God bequeath and give to Mary a Lived and Browning
my lawful wife the properties herein named to wit I want her
to have the same place where I now live to be hers in
the following conditions to wit that she is not take in to
live with her any of the children either here or since nor is
she to take them to the Dowry But I want her to run and
live in the place. Further is she to use timber off the place
any further than is necessary for the use of the place is
to have the same as long as she lives a widow or her
natural life unless she should take the children of
either party to live with her on the Dowry with them
in such case she is to be dispossessed of all her
right and the Dowry of land sold and distributed as follows
Between the heirs of John the Survivors are as follows
Eveline Stafford the Robert A. Aubrey and his heirs by his
present wife and the heirs of Anne the James Brainerd the Dowry
announcing and saying as follows to wit Announcing at the office
Race there a boundary up the Hill by where a run up
forked Chestnut hoofed down then a by a well Cherry
standing near the fence and road Southern down to
thence South, direction to the Anderson branch so as to
show out James Brown's House thence up the Anderson
branch to Cedar line thence so as to include the west
end of my land it being all I own west of the said
line I also give and bequeath to my wife a certain Red
cow and calf and all my hogs and two head of sheep and a
certain two year old filly dark bay face
with three white feet and two Pigs of Mountain and Kitchen
