and bequeath unto my beloved son Rosa Reynolds one negro
boy named David and I give and bequeath unto my beloved
son William Reynolds one negro girl named Eliza who it two
negroes I give unto my daughter named Louisa out of my estate
and allow the rest of my children and I give and bequeath
unto my beloved wife Hannah Reynolds one horse and saddle worth
sixty Dollars and one cow and calf and one bed and furniture and one set
of plates and all my cupboards and one trunk and chest and
twenty five dollars in money the horse and cow & calf that
I give unto my wife at her death is to be returned and
given up to my heirs and all the balance that I give unto her
she is or may dispose of as she thinks proper and then after all
my just debts is paid I wish all the balance of my estate to be
equally divided between all my children to wit Mary Rosa
William and George and I do hereby constitute and ordain appoint
my worthy friends John Jones William Reynolds Executors of this
my last will and Testament. I do hereby declare this to be my last
will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this 26th day of October 1830

 negro woman and judge her freedom at my decease and I do
 also allow all my just debts to be paid out of my estate
 or the above above parties parties to settle it out of the
 estate I intend to them jointly and I do hereby appoint
 my brother John McGowan sole Executor of this my last
 Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto
