Patsy Betsey Benjamin Dacey one dollar each I give and bequeath
unto my son Simon Goodman one cow and calf I give
and bequeath unto my beloved wife my still during her life
& also give and bequeath unto her all my notes and accounts
all my stile cases my whiskey my blacksmith tools my
two waggon my plantation stock of every description my
great fat corn and wheat and all the residue and remainder
of my estate and for her to pay my just debts I acknowledge
this codicil and annex it to my last will and Testament

of Transier the following negroes with their offspring or increase
to wit 1 Ucha and her children named as follows David Jesse Sarah
David Judah Sylvia and also iness the residue of my estate
consisting of my house hold furniture water and stock &c

Kind's & wife and bequeath to my Daughter William
 that house (and my Grandson James E. Jordan which is
 to be equally divided between them after all my just
 debts being paid out of the same And I hereby make and
 ordain my Grandson James E. Jordan Executor of this my
 last Will and Testament with my friend William H. Storch
 in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
 the day and year above mentioned 2

Supplement

In the Name of God Amen. I William Lloyd of the County
 of Franklin & State of Tennessee Being of sound mind and
 memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in
 manner & form as follows: I bequeath my soul to God & my
 body to be decently buried & buried. I give and bequeath unto
 my Son Alexander Lloyd that part of the tract of land I live on
 that lies on west my plantation for two hundred acres (the the
 same more or less) Beginning at an Irony Butledge's old corner
 and my No. 1 corner running South forty five degrees West
 with my line so far that a parallel line with my other line
 South 45 East as well run within two poles of the upper fence
 as it now stands to him his heirs & assigns forever I also give
 to my said son Alexander my negro man and to him his
 heirs & assigns forever I also give him one half forever. I give
 & give and bequeath to my son Eliza Lloyd that part of the tract
 of land I live on that lies South west of the same as it
 now stands running a parallel line from my head line
 through the middle of the said land so as to strike a black
 oak in said land. This is as to run parallel with the
 Lloyd's line as above said 45 East. To him his heirs and
 assigns forever. I also give my son Eliza my negro man
 George to him his assigns forever. I also do give him one
 half forever. I give and bequeath to my Grandson William
 & Eliza Lloyd sons of David Lloyd deceased all the Tracts of
 or parcel of land lying between Alexander and Eliza Lloyd
 part as above described, to be equally divided between them
 share and share alike, and in case of the death of one or the
 other the survivor to enjoy the whole of him and his heirs forever
 provided in death should take place before he or they come of age
 but it is to be expressly understood that my Grand Daughter
 Nancy Lloyd sister to said William & Eliza shall have such
