

I Elizabeth Simmons of the County of Franklin & State of Tennessee being of sound mind & memory do make and ordain this my last will & Testament Testis I first I give and bequeath to my son Peter Simmons a note & bond on him due three days after date & dated 13<sup>th</sup> December 1837 for one thousand & twenty five dollars also the following negroes to set "Booster" and Lucia under the following conditions that is that the said Peter Simmons do not to sell him out or part said negroes under an overseer and at his death said negroes to go to Lucy Mosby wife of Thos F. Mosby until the estate be settled Also a lot & house in Salem Tn 2<sup>nd</sup> I give and bequeath to my son William Simmons a note & bond on him due the 2<sup>nd</sup> January 1838 for one hundred & twenty five dollars with the credit of four hundred dollars paid by or on or about 1830 3<sup>rd</sup> I nominate to constitute and appoint my son Peter Simmons Executor of this my last will & Testament. Given under my hand and seal this 4<sup>th</sup> day of February 1843

Having here before given my negro girl America to my son Peter Simmons since which time said negro girl has had a child & now give and bequeath to my son Peter said child named George and further more and said negro girl may have & at his death to Lucy Mosby wife of Thos F. Mosby given under my hand and seal this 24<sup>th</sup> day of August 1843
