

I Elizabeth Annimons of the County of Transylvania and State of Tennessee being of sound mind ^{and} Voluntary do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament Touching I gave and bequeath to my son Peter Annimons a note I hold on him due three days after date & dated 13th December 1837 for One thousand ^{and} Twenty five dollars also the following negroes Touching I bequeath to my son America under the following conditions that is that the said Peter Annimons do not take him out or put said negro under an overseer and at his death said negro to go to my daughter wife of Thos J Massey under the same conditions Also a lot I own in Salem Tenn 2nd I give and bequeath to my son William Annimons a note I hold on him due the 2nd January 1838 for one hundred & Twenty five dollars with the credit of four hundred dollars paid 6th March 1838 3rd I nominate constitute and appoint my son Peter Annimons Executor of this my last Will and Testament I give under my hand and seal this 4th day of February 1843

I Elizabeth Annimons make the following Codicil to my last Will and Testament Touching I have heretofore given my negro girl America to my son Peter Annimons under which time said negro girl has had a child & now give and bequeath to my son Peter said child named George and further my will is said negro girl may have & at his death to go to my daughter wife of Thos J Massey given under my hand and seal this 24th day of August 1843
