


I George Sande of the County of Franklin and State of Tennessee being now sick but having of sound mind and memory to make and ordain this to be my Last Will and Testament. First my will and desire is that the one half of my land be sold to pay the balance that I owe for it if sufficient and all my just debts be paid. Second, I give the second more to my wife Elizabeth and all my stock of horses cattle and house hold furniture. Thirdly my desire is that John Glashy have one bay mare and one two old geldings in part of what I owe him. Lastly I appoint my friend Robert Glashy Esq. Execut<sup>r</sup> of this my last Will and Testament here by renouncing all former titles in Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affix my seal this twenty sixth day of January 1818

I Nathaniel Ewing Lura County and State of Virginia living of sound disposing mind and memory do hereby and ordain this as my last Will and Testament in manner and form following: First and principally I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God and my body to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named and after my debts and funeral expences are paid I leave and bequeath to my wife Elizabeth Ewing sole execut<sup>r</sup> of this my last Will and Testament the sum of all my real and personal property in the State of Virginia and long used during her life after which it devend to her heirs former and lastly I do constitute & appoint my loving wife Elizabeth Ewing sole Execut<sup>r</sup> of this my last Will and Testament the Testimony whereof I have written. Set my hand and affixed my seal this nineteenth day of February 1818
