Transden County and State of Tennessee do make and ordain this
my last will and Testament as follows viz. I give my body
to be buried at the discretion of my wife and then my
just debts to be paid I give and bequeath to my loving
wife Ann Herford during her life one Negro man named
Hoses and two of the best feather beds and furniture two cows
and calves or yearling and as many of the sheep as she thinks
fit to keep and as many hogs and my household furniture
and two of the best of horses such as she shall choose and
her life time on the land that I bore on Cumberland River
in Transden County and at her death I give the said land to my
sons William Paul and the money that I gave to James Estill
for a negro woman by the name of Horcer which we are at
law for and three three year old steers for to sell for to uphold
the law suit and the balance of my living all but the farming
tools I leave them to my wife her life time and the balance
of my Estate to be sold and the money to be equally divided
among my and at her death the balance to be sold and the
money to be equally among my children Sarah Scott Anne Stanley

I give and bequeath as follows First I bequeath to my
dearly beloved wife Samuel Woods the Plantations I now
live on with all its appurtenances Together with all of
my household furniture and farming utensils of of every kind
also three negroes named Union Doll & Francis also six head
of horses also all my meat cattle and the whole of my hogs
during her natural life at her decease the estate to be
returned and vested in my nephew Andrew Woods my
Brother Peter Woods son if my nephew before mentioned should
