I Ja cob Awaat do make and publish this as my last will and testament
Awaat, hereby revoking and making void all other Wills by me at any time
made first I do it that my former and present debts and all other
debts be paid as soon after my death as possible out of any
monies that I may be possessed of or may first come due to
the hands of my Executors. I do hereby give and bequeath to my
son Joshua Awaat the portion of my land on which I now
live in the divide commencing in the North corner known
as the Sugar tree corner the North west corner formerly the
corner track of School land thence East with the said line to
where it crosses Gable's branch thence up said branch
to where the road crosses said branch thence North two
miles a place known as the Baldy field thence west to G
F Rogers field thence South so as to include said field
thence west to the top of the Hill thence North with said
ridge to a place known as the quarry line thence West
to the old School land line thence South to the Beginning
thence I give and bequeath to Nancy A Rogers my daughter
all my land lying East of Gable's branch and
all East of the same running North to or near the Baldy
field including the place where she now lives. I
further I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Rogers
all the share of my land including where she now
lives. I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Rogers
thirty dollars I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary
thirty dollars I give and bequeath to my daughter Emily
thirty dollars I also do it that all my
house and personal property if there be any at the time
of my death be sold and regularly divided with the three
last mentioned heirs. Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint
Joshua Awaat and George Rogers my Executors in which
whereof I do to this my last will set my hand and seal
this 26th day of January 1866
