and any heirs after named be inclined to dispose of any of said estate she is
unprofitable or to dispose of such part as they may
think must conduce to them my desire is that my son Thomas
Williams be paid out of my estate the sum of sixty Dollars in lieu
of a home he set over his part or equal share to the rest of my
other sons if he or his legal heirs apply for it if not he claimed
to remain to the rest of my property together with his equal
share to be divided among at the death of my legal heirs hereafter
named. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary of County
formerly Nancy Suttonwhite the sum of one hundred Dollars and one
half and I give and bequeath to her daughter Patsy Williams which they have
already paid as for the said Nancy's full part or portion of my
estate. I give and bequeath unto Paul Suttonwhite, Paul
Suttonwhite Thomas Suttonwhite & Patsy Suttonwhite who has entered
married with Benjamin Middleton children of my above named
daughter Nancy one equal share or child's part to be equally divided between
them. I give and bequeath one equal share or portion of my estate
unto my daughter Patsy's children formerly Patsy Camp now deceased
that is to say William Camp John Camp Susan Camp born on
Camp Dr. & Charles Camp Benjamin & David Camp to be equally divided
between them. I give unto my son Benjamin Williams I give
and equal share or portion of my estate except fifty dollars which
he hath already paid in a debt on which it is to be paid in his part
or share I give unto my son Paul Williams I give an equal share or
part. I give unto my son John Williams I give and bequeath one
equal share or part. I give unto my son Thomas Williams one share or equal
part unto my daughter Susan who is now married with William
H. String. I give and bequeath one equal share or part of my estate to
my son David to be divided as hereafter mentioned I am the first place and
lastly I constitute ordain and appoint my son John Williams and Thomas A
Williams Executors to my estate. I hereby my last will and Testament
I hereby do annul and revoke all former wills or wills in witness whereof I
have hereunto set my name and affixed my seal this sixteenth day of
February and in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
thirteen William and Benjamin were called before me and
signed sealed and delivered and acknowledged
in presence of us before being witnessed
himself.
