Sister Abby I will my Corn and Cotton to my Father and
to Sister Abby and Sarah I will all my Bacon to her
and Sister Abby I will all my book accounts to brother
and Sister Abby I will my bed to Mother and Child. I will
my feathers to Sister Abby I will say two stone pug - t.
Mother and Sister Abby". Do ^{hurry} nominate and appoint Joseph
Champion and William Champion Executors to this my
last Will and Testament in witness & have hereunto set my
hand and affixed my seal this twenty first day of October
Eighteen hundred and Fifteen

I thank God and calling to mind the uncertainty of human
life and being desirous to dispose of such worldly substance
as it has pleased God to bestow upon me with & give and
bequeath the same in manner and form following: I give
and bequeath to my wife Polly all my Personal
Property for the use of her Children as long as she
continues single and after her death the property to be equally
divided among the children of myself and my beloved
wife Polly as aforesaid Item all the money that is due
me I will to have applied to the purchasing of land which
land I allow for the Benefit and use of my beloved wife
Polly and our children living for her support during her
natural life or if she should die after her death to
be equally divided between our two sons Item
to my Daughter Rachel I give and bequeath out of my personal
property One horse and saddle and hatty I do appoint my

Friend Hugh Montgomery Executor of this my last will and
Testament Thirly authorizing Constituting nominating and
appointing him to proper and Lawful execution of the same
given to me in my presence and under my hand and seal this 15th
Oct 1814

In the Name of God Amen I This am James Cawell of the County of Franklin
and State of Tennessee being weak in body but of perfect mind and
memory blessed be God do this Seventeenth Day of January in the year of
our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred and Sixteen make this my
last will and Testament in manner following that is to say principally
and first of all I give and recommend my Soul into the hands of
a mighty God taking care of it and my body I recommend to the
Earth to be buried in the decent Christian Burial nothing doubting
but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the
Power of almighty God and touching my worldly Estate that God has
pleased to bless me with in this life I give and bequeath the
same in the following manner and form First I give and bequeath
unto my beloved wife Anne free possession of my Plantation
with my working tools one mose saddle and bridle one
choice cow one bed and furniture one horse one oxen one ox
one Sheller and the other furniture and one Ewe and one lamb
and one Bee Stand during her lifetime or widowhood. I also
give unto my two sons James and John my wagon and guns
one Bee Stand apiece and one yoking hife to John one bed
two yea old filly between James and John divided equally
between themselves I also give to my Daughters Anne one Cow
one old Brown Filly one Bed and Furniture and one large pot
I also give to my daughter Elizabeth one Horse and white cow
one bed and Furniture and one pot also give to my daughter
Sally one Old and white Cow one bed and Furniture and one
pot there is one Brown mose that is to be divided between
Elizabeth and Sally equally and her increase the balance thereof
to the use and benefit of my surviving family. I also give my
land to my two youngest sons George and Thomas and to be
equally divided at the separation of their mothers life or widow
hood of. My wife Anne and son James I further constitute
Executor and Executor to have this my last will and Testament
lawfully Executed and so hereby wholly disallow made and
disavowed are and among others former Testaments Wills Legacies
Bequests and Executions by me in any ways before named reviled
and impeached rather than fulfilling and performing this and no other to
