

any gift bequest matter or thing in this my will given and bequeathed expressed or contained that there no suit or suits in law or Equity or otherwise shall be brought commenced or prosecuted for and concerning the same shall be referred wholly to the award of three good men chosen by the Chancery of the Family Court and what they shall order direct or determine therein shall be binding and conclusive to all and every person therein concerned him by and lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my three eldest sons James Thierman Isaac Thierman William Thierman and my brother in law Isaac Miller son of Rutherford County Executors to this my last will and Testament giving them my Executors the guardianship of the property of my first youngest children named in this will and it is my wish and desire that any two of the subscribing witnesses making oath in open Court shall be sufficient evidence to prove this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all others by me heretofore made signed sealed published and declared by the above named John Thierman to be his last will and Testament in the presence of us who have heretofore subscribed our names as witnesses in the presence of the Testator this Tenth day of August in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and thirty.

I James Harris of Transylvania County and State of Tennessee being to record the mortality of my body and that it is appointed for a time once to die and it being my desire that the said estate might be as respect my worldly affairs I have constituted and ordained this to be my last will and Testament and it is my will and desire that my property and effects be disposed of in the following manner my I bequeath to my dear wife Susan at the plantation on which I now live estimated two hundred and thirty acres with all the negroes now in my possession also all my coming interests and tools of my dear wife Susan also all my household furniture and kitchen appointments with all my stock of horses

cattle sheep and hogs to remain in my dear wife Susannah's possession care and management during her lifetime or widowhood for the use and support of the widow and 3 children which are now unmarried and at home with her I further will and desire at the death of my wife Susannah the negroes with their increase be divided equally between my three sons Samuel David and James also that the plantation with all the tools stores &c as above described remain in the possession of the unmarried part of the family for their use and support as long as they may think proper to live on the plantation but so soon as they unanimously agree to live on it no longer it shall be sold and the proceeds equally divided amongst all my children viz. David Rebecca Samuel worthy Mary Rhoda David Susannah and James and all the balance of personal property and household furniture then belonging to the plantation shall be divided equally between the unmarried children I also will and desire that at any time any of the stores or perishable property should become troublesome expensive or useless to them it shall be sold and the money appropriated to the use to the use of the children and family I do further will and desire that if any of my children should think proper to marry that they shall receive their proportion of the stores household furniture and provisions which may be on hand to be given at the discretion of the widow and Executors I do hereby constitute and appoint my dear wife Susannah and my three sons Samuel David David & James B Horne Executors of this my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this thirtieth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight Signed sealed in the presence of
