Freeman Lloyd second the sum of five dollars each then I give
and bequeath to the Elk River Baptist Church one acre of ground
to include the meeting house in the Center provided said
church should become extinct said acre shall next be left
to my son Elisha Lloyd then I also will that one acre
of ground be set apart for ever for a burying ground at the
opposite place of burial then I also give to grandson William
son of David Lloyd the oldest of the gray colts then I also
give my wagon & gear for the use of the plantation &
also will that my negro man Woulam be permitted to
keep or sell his property as may suit him then I that
should there be any money stock or other property left over
and above that already bequeathed that it be equally divided
among my surviving daughters. Lastly I do hereby appoint
my my sons Alon and Elisha Lloyd sole Executors of this my
last will and Testament ratifying this & revoking all former

In the Name of God Amen; I Robert Bork being unwell in Body but sound in mind Calling to remembrance the mortality of all things that one flesh must return to the dust from whence it came do make Constatute and ordain this my last Will and Testament (as) as follows the first and chief object is that God will receive my soul when it leaves this Tabernacle of clay and that my and that my Body be returned at the discretion of my Executors and as to my temporal affairs I wish them conducted in the following manner Item 1st I will at a proper time that all my just debts be paid out of the Personal Property it is here expressed God to sustain one one and the remainder I leave in the manner following Item 2nd I leave to my beloved wife Jane a support from my land during her life or until she is to be at her disposal Item 3rd I leave to my son John Robert George James Micajah Goodwin equally all equal parts of the balance of my land and premises not appropriated. Item 3rd I leave to my two Daughters Ruth & Anne one hundred Dollars each out of my stock and household furniture to make them equal to the other Daughters that are married Item 5th in addition to my wife James Legacy above I leave her our smaller bedstead & all the white in the par and one bed and bedclothes Item 6th I leave the balance of my property equally between my four Daughters Mary Ann married to H. Parker Joy and Sarah who is married to Charles McDonald Ruth and Anne alone stated to be married among them lastly I constitute ordain and appoint John Jones and George Bork my Executors to this my last Will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this 2nd day of July in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty one JRB witnessed and crossed before signed
