 aforesaid & purchase a negro girl with it of such description as they
 may think proper and to be conveyed to them when purchased as
 aforesaid to my daughter Averlea to her and her heirs forever.
 Secondly I direct that the residue of the money arising from the
 sale of my property and collection of debts as aforesaid be equally
 be equally divided between the children of my children.
 Lastly I appoint George Percins and Joseph Bell Executors of this
 my last will and Testament hereby revoking all former wills
 I have under my hand and seal this 18th of Oct 1826

 Division. And I do hereby appoint my beloved wife Jenny Spurgeon
 Edward Reese & Francis A. Barquist my Executors to this my
 last Will and Testament and I do hereby revoke all former Wills
 by me heretofore made Ratifying and confirming this to be
 my last Will and Testament. In Testimony whereof I have

 of my sons John three children John Isaac & David five
 dollars each the balance to be equally divided amongst all
 my children I also nominate and appoint John Siler and
 Maudlin Reese sole Executors of this my last Will and
 Testament hereby revoking all former Wills and Testaments by me
 made & witnesses whereof I have hereto set my hand and seal
 this 2nd July 1821. Signed Sealed published and declared by the
