 Stamps all of my land and negro together with every other species
 of property belonging to my estate at my death or before she said
 Sarah Stamps his to have and hold all the above named property during
 her life or her widow hood. But provided the said Sarah Stamps
 on my then share this will be come full and void and of none effect
 during the said Sarah Stamps lifetime when to live in the full and
 free possession of all the above named property. And she is hereby
 fully authorized and empowered to sell trade or transfer any piece
 of property either land or negro or any species of property provided
 that such sale is done through the advice and consent of her son
 Daniel B. Stamps my negro girl Linda at Sarah Stamps death I
 desire my daughter Jane to have her and keep her as long as she
 lives and I never intend her exposed to public sale for then all
 my land or which I have lying East of the Nashville wall is hereby
 released conveyed and confirmed unto D.B. Stamps junior
 as witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal.
