 utensils which I have lent to her as herein before mentioned may
 bequeath divided among all my children & apt my son in law
 George Russell and his wife my loving heretofore given and
 conveyed to him a negro slave of the value of \$400 - but
 should it appear on the division of the property that is to
 say the stores stock household and kitchen furniture which
 is to be divided among the residue of my children after the
 decease of my wife that the residue of the children's
 said portions get a larger portion than your husband
 dollars then and in that case my son in law George
 Russell is to come in for so much of the said stores
 stock household & kitchen furniture as will make his
 portion including the stores heretofore given him of the
 value of your husband dollars equal to the portion that the
 other children may receive from a division of said stores
 stock household & kitchen furniture. I do hereby appoint my
 friend Joseph Miller and my son in law George Russell
 executors of this my last will and Testament hereby
 avowing the former Charles Sumner under my hand and
 seal this 22nd day of August 1823.

 County of Franklin State of Tennessee being well in body
 but of sound mind and memory calling to mind the
 mutability of all things and the uncertainty to its other
 Earth from whence it come. And the immortal part to
 the great Author of all created things and acknowledging that
 my life is short in this world I feel it my duty
 and privilege to make constitute and ordain this my
 last will and Testament first that my goods and in my
 body at some convenient time and place after my death
 I wish that all my just debts be paid. Then I do
 give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Margaret Smith
 my dwelling house and its contents at this time. Papers
 I expect I shall be dead and for her to dispose of as she
 thinks proper also one negro man named George one
 cow also one Gray mare which is to belong to Charity
 Sumner at her death then 2nd having heretofore given the
 children Leah Sumner Jane McHenry under lifetime and
 Mary and her Rachel McHenry and James Smith a large
 amount of property I have before given to my eldest son

Jeremiah Smith Therefore to make him equal with the
rest of my heirs I bore him all my stock of cattle not
otherwise bequeathed with one wagon one steel & shovels one
set of blacksmith tools. Item 3rd I bore to my daughter
Elizabeth and his heirs one dollar bearing them a free and equal
share of my estate Item 4th I bore to my daughter Rachel
of color one negro woman named Rosa Item 5th I bore
and bequeath the lease of my of my property to my joint
children Jeremiah Smith & John Bonds & my son & daughter
Rachel McDaniel & James Smith those and those alive
Item 6th I bore my friend Col. Benjamin Hallingworth sole
Executor to this my last will and Testament "In witness where

namely, I give my body to the Lord in which I trust
at the discretion of my Executors and my soul to God who
gives it; Secondly I give that all my just debts be
paid out of the monies left on hand or, Thirdly I will and bequeath
to my beloved wife Kimba the sole and entire care and possession
and possession of all my property left at my decease both real
and personal to her sole use and benefit to be used disposed
of as she may think proper and at her decease to be there
